



POT PEOPLE—Figure pots, such as the ones shown here, from part of the display of the works of Harold Keller currently at the OU Art Museum. These figure pots represent a chariot rider (top left), women on a seesaw (top right), woman on a ram (bottom left) and Leda and the swan (bottom right). The pots, made of

unglazed terra cotta and white pottery, are approximately half a foot tall. Nine pots are exhibited in addition to 17 paintings and 5 drawings. Keller, a graduate student of painting at OU in 1949-50 is currently a teacher of art and philosophy at Fort Smith Junior College in Arkansas. (Transcript Photos)
